
### **NEW from Red Leaf Pianoworks!**



Around the World by Irene Voros – 8 Intermediate Piano Solos inspired by cities and countries from around the world. Explore rich harmonies, creative melodies, jazz chords, and blues bass lines in these evocative pieces.

Young students shine with pride as their child-like, jolly little pieces transform into a truly special musical experience. Young pianists will have Christmas memories that will last.



## **Spring 2015 with Red Leaf Pianoworks**

**Janet Gieck's Dream Sequence** for flute, clarinet and piano was commissioned and performed by the Galliard Foundation in Saskatoon this winter. Also this winter, she presented a Red Leaf Pianoworks workshop for the Saskatchewan Registered Music Teachers' Association. Janet also adjudicated festivals in Kindersley and Maple Creek, Saskatchewan in March.

**John Burge** premiered all of his *Twenty-Four Preludes* for solo piano in Kingston early in 2015. These pieces have been in the works for the past few years, some of which he performed in smaller sets in previous years. Drawing inspiration from the sets by Chopin and Debussy, eight of the preludes use extended instrumental techniques such as strumming the strings inside the piano, but always in a very tonal fashion. Look for the complete set in the **Red Leaf Pianoworks** catalogue later in the fall.

**Susan Griesdale** presented a workshop at Long & McQuade – a presentation of Red Leaf Music that's in the new RCM Syllabus (and more) in Toronto on May 15<sup>th</sup>. She also adjudicated at the Toronto Davenport Festival in April, then May 23<sup>rd</sup> for the Newmarket ORMTA Scholarship Recital.

Martha Hill Duncan has been busy adjudicating music festivals in Peel Region and Peterborough, Ontario. As well she has presented talks at Queen's University – "Breaking Into Song: The Thrill of Setting Text To Music" and "Nurturing the Artist in Each and Every Student" to the Denver Music Society. She has also completed the piano and choral song, "Step to the Fiddle" for the Children's Choir Commissioning Consortium of Graphite Publishing of Minneapolis. Her Gr. 9 piano piece Monarchs was also chosen for the RCM Video Challenge in honour of the new Celebration Series.

# **Upcoming Events**

**Janet Gieck's** *Homage* for trumpet, violin, cello, electric guitar, prepared piano and percussion was commissioned and will be premiered by the Strata New Music Festival in June.

**Joanne Bender, Martha Hill Duncan, Susan Griesdale, Beverly Porter, Teresa Richert and Irene Voros** will be present at the CFMTA Conference in Vancouver, July 18 – 25, 2015 (Trade Show Booth #20). In a fun-filled session entitled "The More the Merrier," the composers will join together in a variety of combinations to showcase piano ensembles for all levels. The presentation, which takes place on Thursday, July 9 at 5 pm, will include insights and anecdotes about the inspiration behind the music as well as tips for teaching.

Martha Hill Duncan and Teresa Richert are presenting a session entitled "Demystifying the Score – Composers' Perspectives" at the CFMTA Conference in Vancouver. The presentation will take place on Friday, July 10 at 9 am. The composers will provide some insight into "reading between the lines" of a score and deciphering the composer's intentions based on their own unique experiences.

John Burge will be a guest speaker at the Summer Sizzle 15 Keyboard Kamp presented by the Canadian National Conservatory of Music in Mount Forest, Ontario from July 19-21, 2015. John was at the 2013 version of Summer Sizzle and was impressed by the sessions for both students and teachers as well as the strong focus on Canadian music, improvisation and composition. He is looking forward to returning. One of the projects on his desk right now is a two-movement work for organ that was commissioned by the Royal College of Canadian Organists through the Ontario Arts Council for their 2017 conference that will be held in Kingston.

**Irene Voros** and **Teresa Richert** are presenting a session for the BCRMTA South Fraser Branch on September 25 in preparation for Canada Music Week. They will featuring elementary to intermediate level repertoire by Red Leaf Pianoworks composers.

**Teresa Richert** is participating in the launch of the Royal Conservatory of Music's *Celebration Series 2015* in Vancouver in Fall 2015. The launch, which will be hosted simultaneously in Vancouver, Calgary and Toronto, will feature performances by leading Canadians and award-winning students of pieces from different musical periods.
