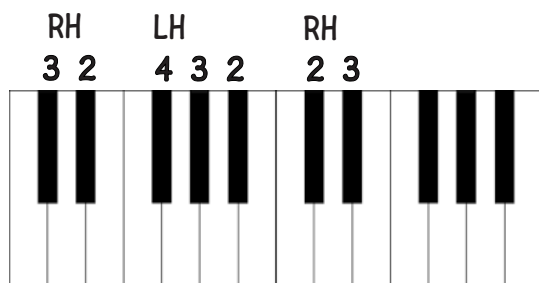


How High Can You Go?
